



Graduation Rates

Graduation rates are calculated based on the fall cohorts composed of students who began the program who are on schedule to graduate on-time. LABI College still reports first-time, full-time cohort graduation rates to the Department of Education (IPEDS) and our accreditation agency. Graduation Rate Terms

“Number of Students Who Began the Program” means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% or 150% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

“Students Available for Graduation” is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have transferred, died, been incarcerated, or are in active military duty.

“Number of On-time Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.

“On-time Completion Rate” is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.

Note: On-time Completion Rate is reported as a percentage (%)
